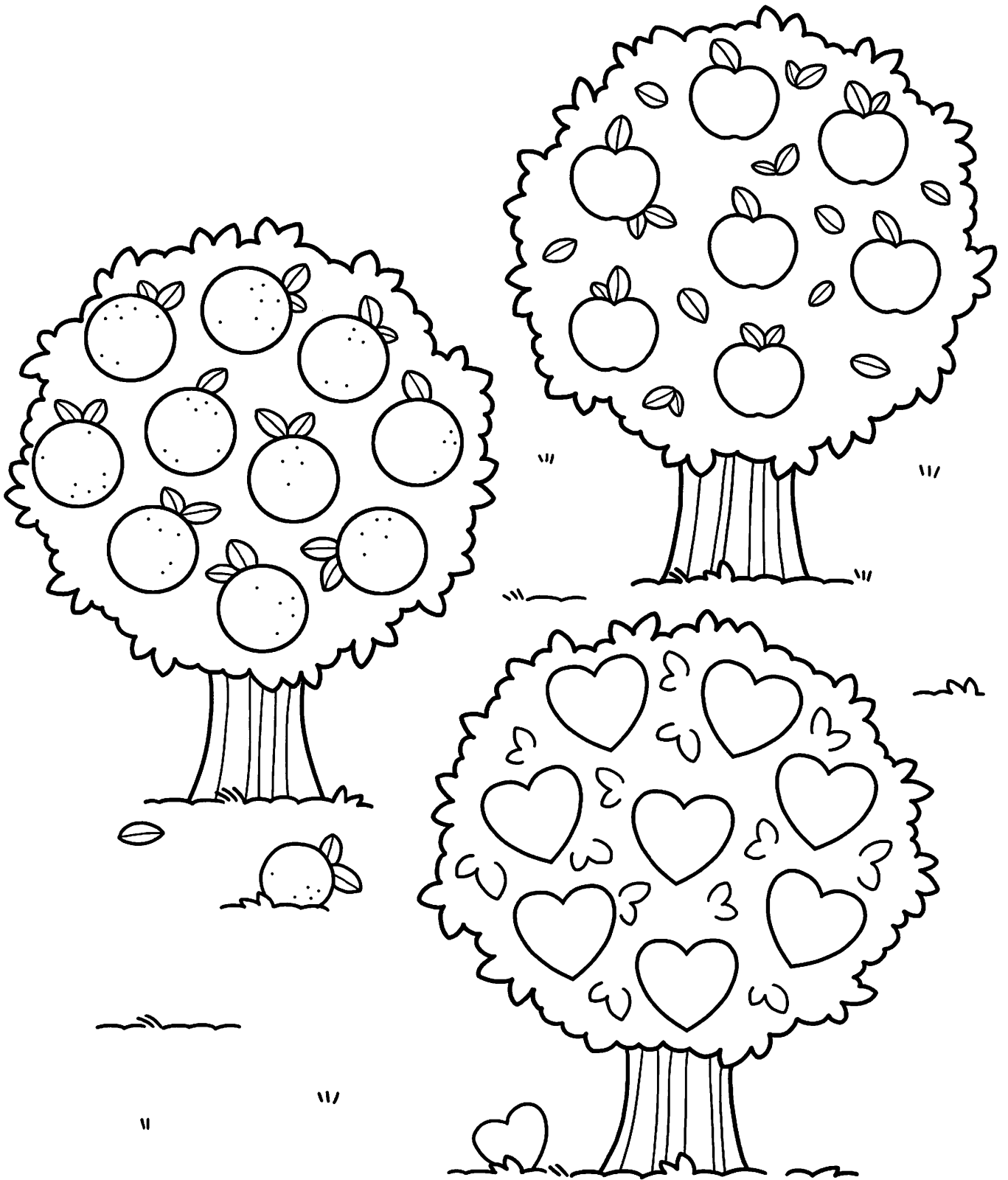

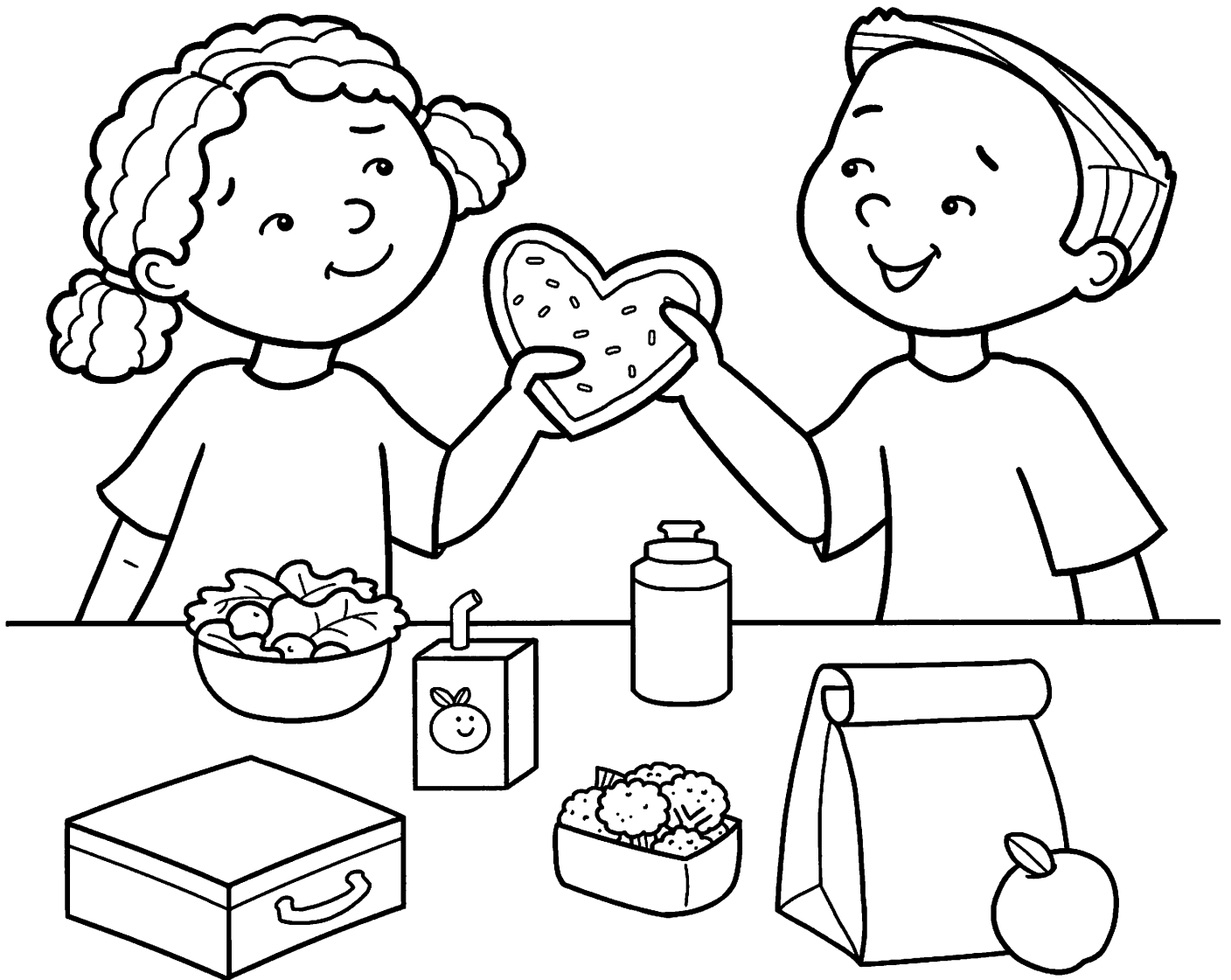

Love shows up in our actions.



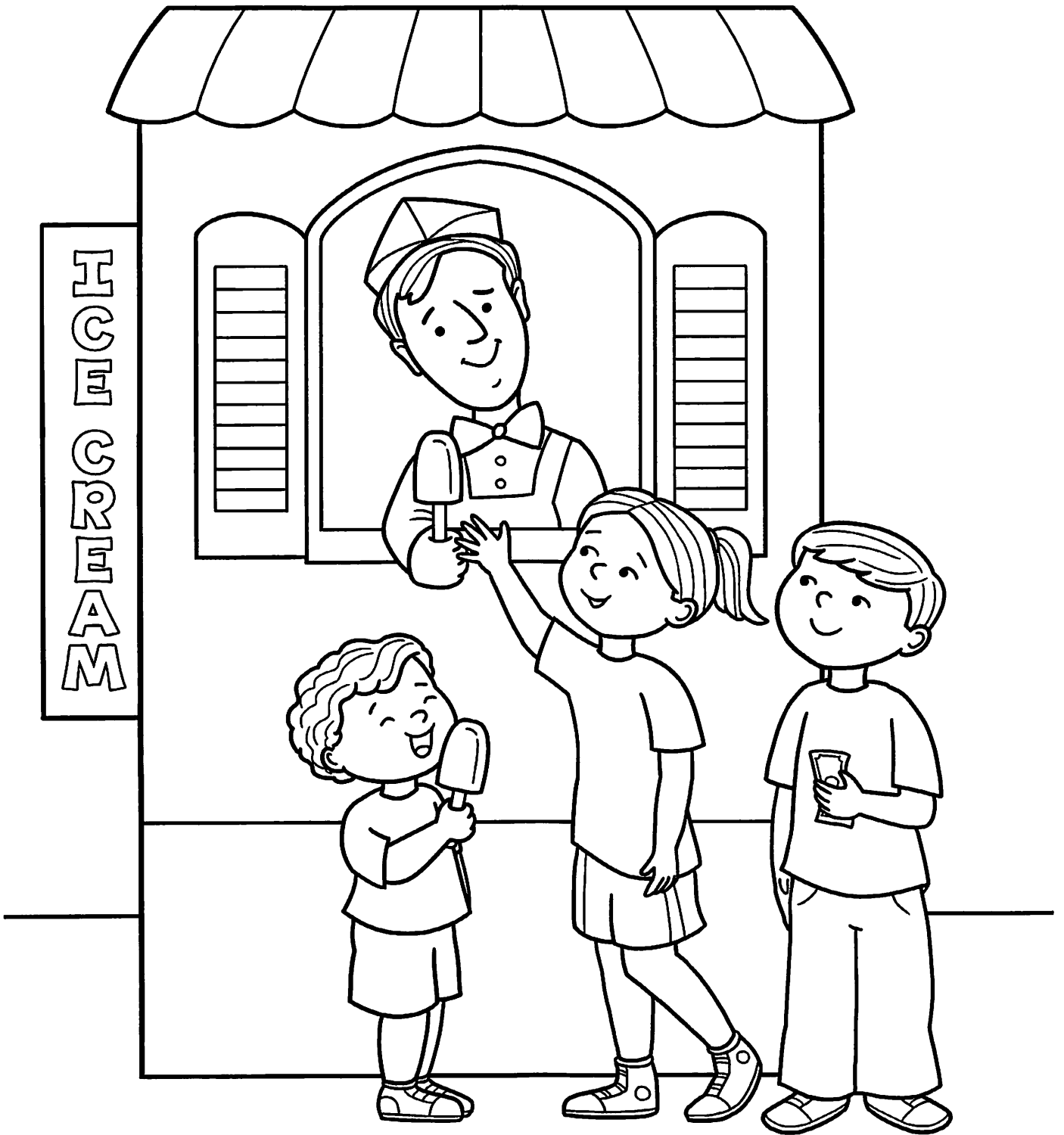
JOY

If you obey, even when no one is looking, you are showing goodness.



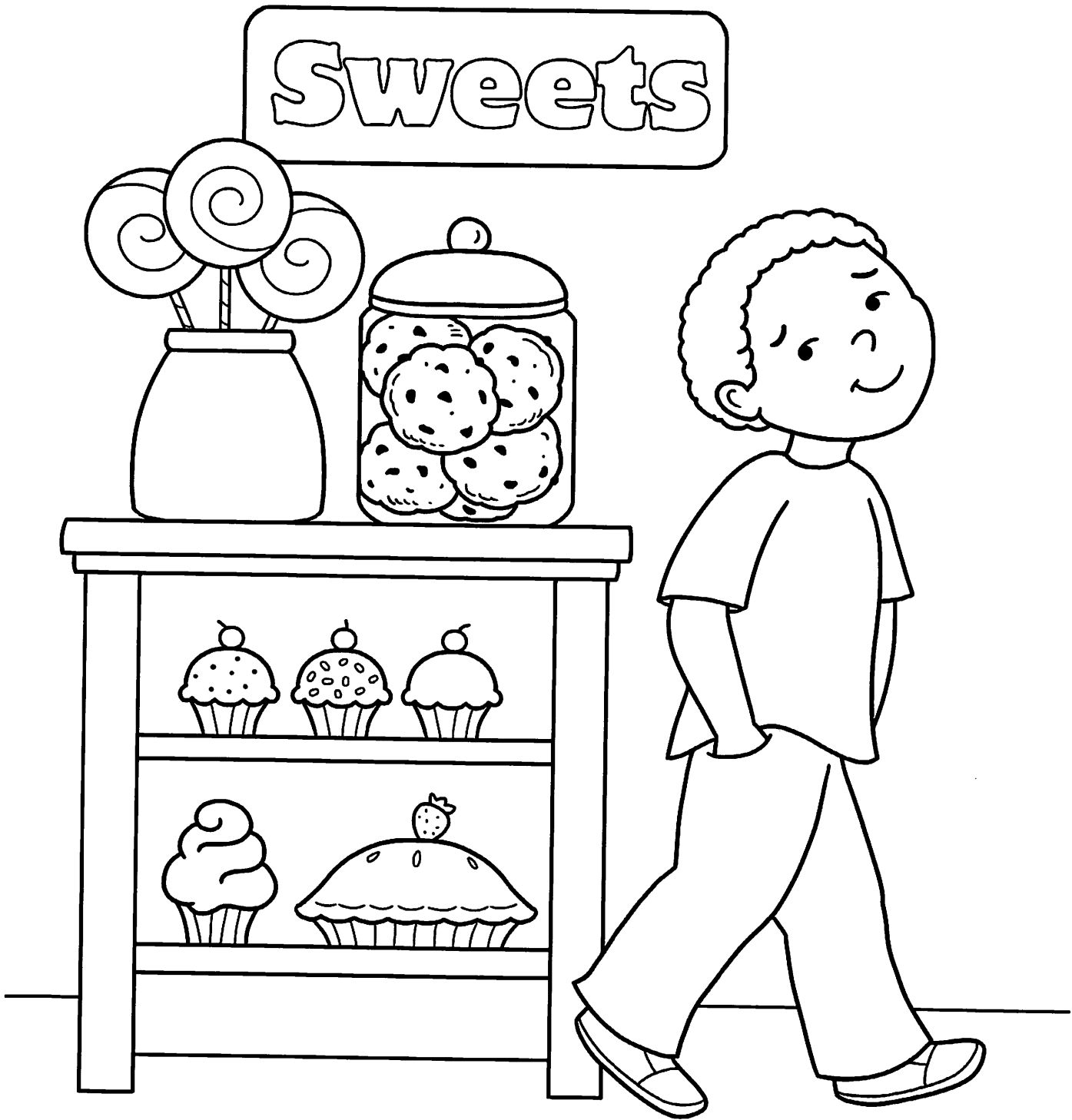
FAITHFULNESS

that's what gentleness is like.

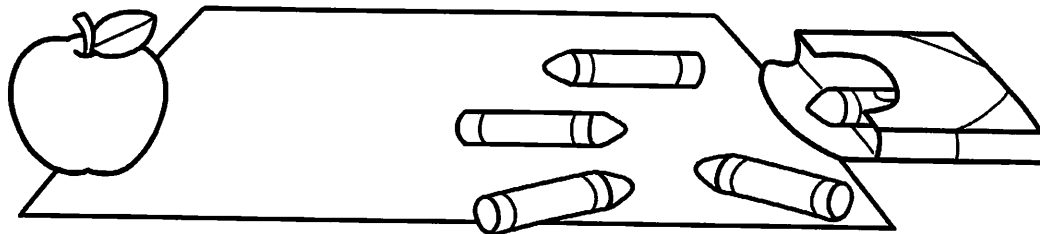


SELF-CONTROL

This is how you grow self-control.



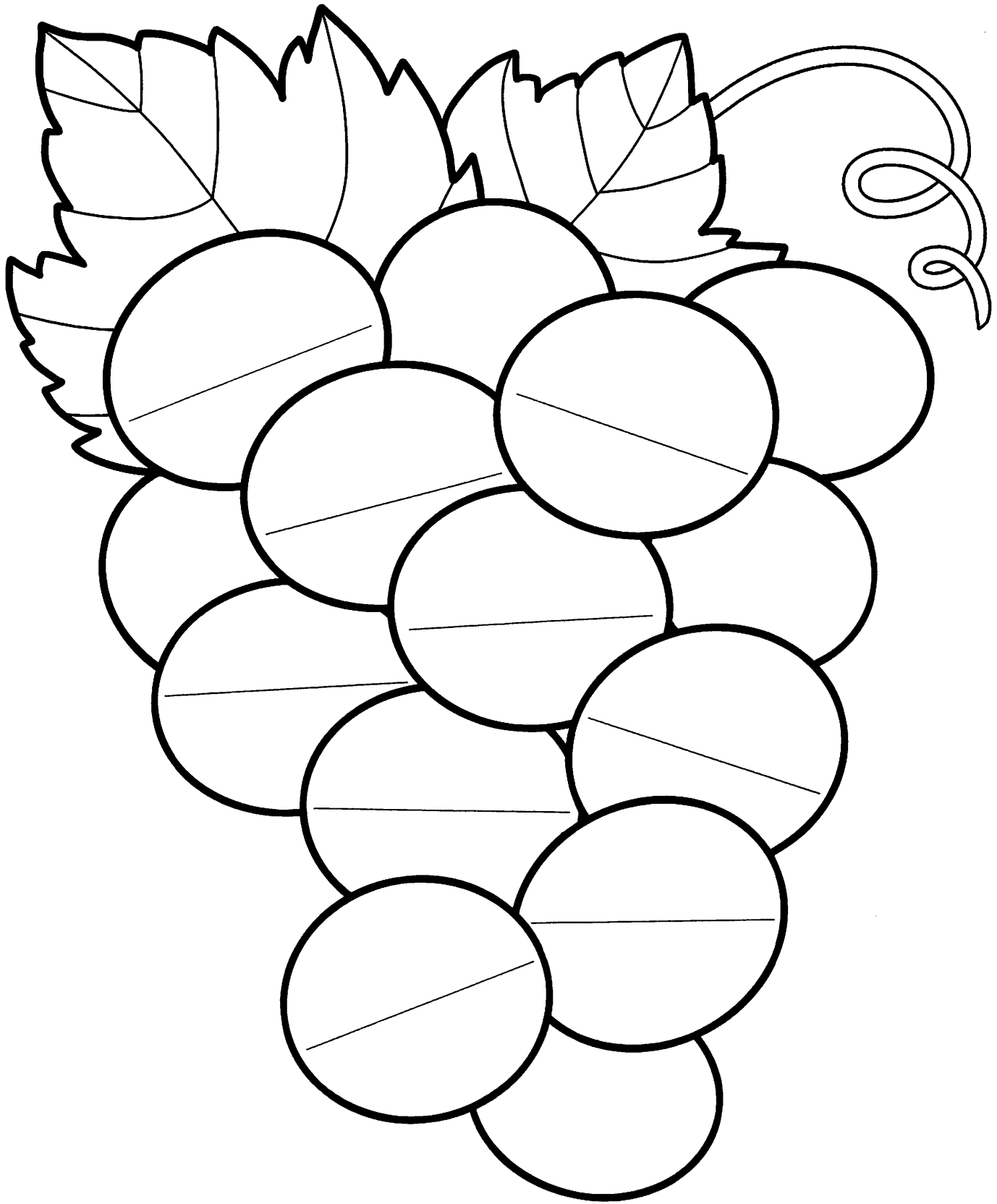
How can you show your mom that you love her?
